We have been conducting an online survey in cooperation with beekeepers!

The project team has been conducting an online survey to reveal the realities and challenges of the Mongolian beekeeping sector. The first survey focused on postwinter conditions, and a total of 44 beekeepers responded. The result showed 12% decrease in the bee colonies during wintering, and 5% loss of queen

bees during and immediately after wintering. The result of the survey were posted on the project Facebook page.

The second survey has started since May 18 to assess the control measures against of varroa mites. Beekeepers are encouraged to participate in this survey.

Collaboration with stakeholders

We regularly exchange information with relevant organizations through online meetings and other means. In early April, a meeting was held with officers from the General Agency for Specialized Inspection to update the beekeeping checklist. At the end of April, information of the project progress



was exchanged with Department of Coordination for Implementation of Animal Husbandry Policy, MoFALI, responsible party for the project. We will continue collaborating effectively with other stakeholders.
